

Scout Kit List

- The kit should be packed in a rucksack or holdall
- All kit **must be named** (including plates & cutlery)
- Scouts should pack their own kit so they know where everything is
- General rule is if it doesn't fit it doesn't go

Small 2-3 Man tent (to be shared with other Scouts)

Sleeping bag

Roll mat

Camp fire blanket

Change of clothes per day plus extra set (trousers & jumper may last 2 days)

Pyjamas

Hiking boots or wellies

Trainers or walking shoes

Waterproof jacket & trousers

Hat

Warm coat / fleece

Gloves

Wash kit & small towel

Plastic bag for dirties

Small personal first aid kit

Plate, bowl, mug & cutlery (knife, fork, spoon)

Tea towel

Torch & spare batteries

Handkerchief

Suncream

Small day sack

Water bottle

Groundsheet / plastic sheeting for airing kit / sitting on

Book or reading material for freetime

No jeans (they take too long to dry if they get wet)

No MP3/iPods, cameras, or mobile phones

No money unless a camp bank has been specified

Scout must travel to & from the campsite in Scout uniform
